- ✓ accountability (muhasabah).



### Defining Leadership:

### **Definition:**

The ability to **influence** others by **guiding** and **motivating** them to achieve a **goal** or adopt a specific **behavior**.

- Intentional Influence: Not just having an audience.
- Purposeful direction and motivation

# Leadership & Management

### Management:

The efficient and effective utilization of resources to achieve desired organizational outcomes.

### **Functions:**

-Planning > Organizing > Staffing > Directing > Controlling

### Classical Theories of Leadership



### **Trait Theory**

- Core Idea: Certain individuals possess specific traits that make them effective leaders.
- Focus: Personal characteristics.

### **Behavioral Theories**

• Core Idea: Leadership is based on observable behaviors rather than innate traits.

### Modern Theories of Leadership - 1



### **Transformational Leadership**

- ✓ motivating through vision & inspiration.
- Engages the team in adopting change.
- ✓ Builds trust, acts as a role model

### **Traits:**

Visionary, emotionally intelligent, value-driven.

### **Servant Leadership**

- ✓ the leader serves the team.
- ✓ to enable them to grow and succeed

#### **Traits:**

Humility, empathy, stewardship.

### Other Modern Theories of Leadership - 2

### Transactional Leadership

a system of rewards and punishments.

### **Authentic Leadership**

 self-awareness, transparency, ethics, and consistency btw values and actions.


### **Adaptive Leadership**

(Al-Baqarah 2:30)

(al-Bukhari & Muslim)



# Step 1: Building the Leadership Mindset



### **Personal Growth**

- ✓ Continuous learning
- ✓ Personal Vision
- ✓ Self Mission

### Step 2: Emotional Intelligence (EI):



- ✓ Self-awareness
- ✓ Self-management
- ✓ Self-motivation
- ✓ Empathy
- √ Communication skills

### Step 3: The Power of Vision in Leadership

What is Vision?
a mental picture of a desired future.

### **❖ Vision vs. Goals:**

- ✓ Vision: the "big picture" of where you are heading.
- ✓ Goals: specific, measurable milestones that take you there.



## Step 4: Strategic Planning: From Vision to Action

### Translating Vision into Practical Strategies:

- 1. Setting SMART goals (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound)
- 2. Aligning resources towards the vision
- 3. Managing time and priorities effectively



## Step 5: Embracing change & Self-Development

- (1) Embracing change:
  - in surat Ar-Ra'd: Allah will not change the condition of people unless they change what's in themselves
- (2) Embracing Tazkiyah: purifying the soul:
  Successful indeed the one who purifies it [his soul]
- **❖** (3) Embracing *Ta'deeb*:
  - 'disciplining of the mind, body and soul'
  - •My Lord disciplined me [addabani], and so made my charactor most excellent"

### Step 6: Embracing Holistic Growth (Tarbiyah)

### \* Tarbiyah in Islam:

the balanced growth of the total personality of Man through the training of Man's spirit, intellect, rational self, feelings and bodily senses.\*

### **❖ Islamic** *Tarbiyah* should cater:

for the growth of man in all its aspects: spiritual, intellectual, imaginative, physical, scientific, linguistic, both individually and collectively and motivates all aspects towards goodness and the attainment of perfection.\* [Ihsaan]
